4 Subject of the declaration:

This declaration applies to all variants of pallet-based transport packaging. The possible components are listed below. The specific composition of each delivery is only a subset of the possible components. However, the requirements of the PPWR for all components in any combination are met and hereby confirmed.

- Cardboard boxes
- Paper adhesive tape
- Plastic adhesive tape
- Paper labels
- PP cardboard straps
- Cardboard interleaving sheets
- Edge protection for cardboard pallets
- PP strapping for pallets
- Polyethylene cover film
- Polyethylene stretch film
- Euro pallet / disposable wooden pallet

Requirements for substances in packaging pursuant to Article 5 of the PPWR:

Article 5 – Substance Restrictions

- According to information from our packaging suppliers, none of the materials used contain hazardous substances such as lead, cadmium, mercury, or chromium VI in concentrations that exceed the limit of 100 mg/kg for the total packaging.
- The packaging is not used for food; nevertheless, we can confirm that, according to information from our packaging suppliers, the limit values for PFAS in the components are complied with.
- The limit values for SVHC, CMR, bisphenols, and MOSH/MOAH are also met, according to information from our packaging suppliers

Article 6 – Recyclability

- Starting in 2030, a minimum recycling rate of 70 % must be guaranteed. We can confirm that this is already the case

- We limit transport packaging to what is necessary, in consultation with our customers, to ensure that our products are adequately protected. There is no overpackaging. Empty spaces are kept to a minimum, as otherwise the products could shift and become damaged inside the transport packaging.

- With the exception of the EU pallet, all other components are not designed for reuse but are largely recyclable
